Interior of the new ferry is designed by Kudos Dsign

The interior designs of the new ferry, which will operate between Vaasa in Finland and Umeå in Sweden, are being finalized. Kudos has produced the interior design plan for Wasaline's new ship. They have designed all public areas of the ferry.

The design is modern, fresh and makes use of natural colours.

The construction of the new ferry for Kvarken Link has started at the Rauma Marine Constructions shipyard and it will replace the existing Wasa Express in traffic in the spring of 2021. It will be operated by Wasaline.
